

There are **Three Ways** to Vote in New York State

Vote by Absentee Ballot

- Go to <https://absenteeballot.elections.ny.gov/> to apply on line.
or Call Board of Elections (BOE (607-274-5522) to ask for an application form
or Go to BOE Office at 128 E. Buffalo St., Ithaca. Fill out a form on the spot and wait to be given your absentee ballot form. (Hours 8:30—5:00 pm)
- **RETURN** ballot by mail postmarked no later than Nov 3. Deliver to BOE office, leave in drop box at early polling sites when open, or any of the 36 polling sites during polling hours on Nov 3. Mailed ballots must arrive by Nov 10.

Vote Early

- Voters can vote early between Sat Oct 24 and Sun Nov 1 at:
 - Town of Ithaca Town Hall, 215 N. Tioga St. Ithaca,
 - Crash Fire Rescue (CFR) 72 Brown Rd. Ithaca (near Tompkins Cty airport)

Early voting hours – Sat & Sun 9 am – 2 pm, Mon & Wed 7 am to 3 pm,
Tue & Thurs 12 noon to 8 pm, and Fri 9 am to 5 pm.

Vote on Election Day November 3

- 36 Polling Sites are open 6:00 am to 9:00 pm
