### **League of Women Voters of Tompkins County Launches [www.Vote411.org](http://www.Vote411.org) Electronic Voter Guide for June Primary Races**

Vote 411, the League's electronic voter guide, is now LIVE! Information is available for all candidates running in the New York State Gubernatorial and Lieutenant Governor races, and in the City of Ithaca 4<sup>th</sup> Ward Alderperson race, for the June 28 primary election.

Candidates were asked to provide biographical details and responses to questions posed by the League, as well as links to their social media and campaign websites. All of this information can be accessed online at [www.vote411.org](http://www.vote411.org) in an easy-to-use electronic format.

Residents of Tompkins County can enter their home address to find out which races they are eligible to vote in, to compare candidate information, and to print a customized sample ballot. Candidates who have not yet submitted their information are listed with "Candidate Has Not Responded;" their responses will be posted as soon as the candidates provide their answers.

The League will be launching a voter guide on Vote411 for the August 23 State Senate and Congressional primary races in early August.
